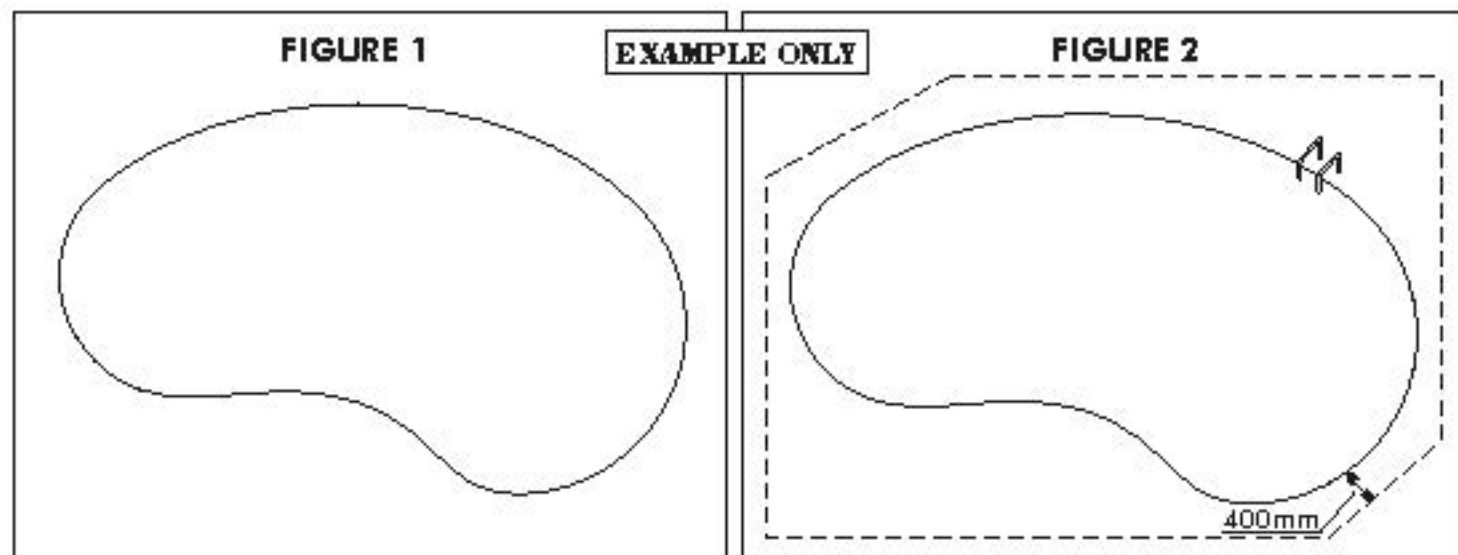

MEASURING INSTRUCTIONS

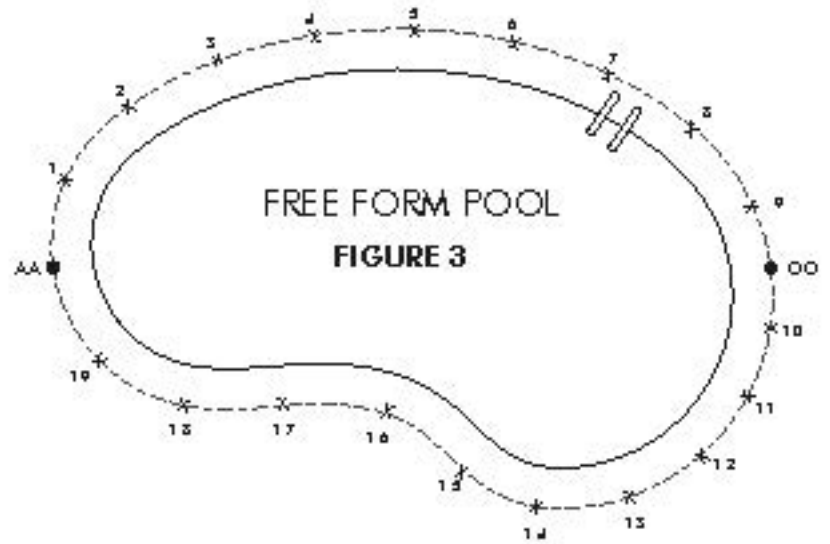
Equipment needed:

- Tape Measure longer than the pool
- Chalk
- An Assistant

1. Begin with a freehand sketch of the inside of your pool (Figure 1)
2. Draw the decking area around your pool, showing any grab rails, rocks, posts, fences and obstacles within 600mm or 2 ft from the waters edge. (Figure 2)



3. The cover will follow the shape of your pool - 300 mm or 1 ft wider and longer than the waters edge of your pool.
4. With a piece of chalk, mark 300mm out from the waters edge at the centre of both ends and mark one end with "AA" and the other with "OO".(Fig3)
5. From point "AA" in a clockwise direction at .8 to 1m intervals, 300mm out from the waters edge, mark 1, 2, 3, 4, 5 . . . etc until you are back to point "AA". Do not number "OO" in your marks. (Fig 3)



Note: If your pool is a rectangle shape, just mark the corners. (See figure 4)

6. Filling in the form provided measure "AA" to "OO".
7. Holding one end of your tape at "AA", measure 1, then "AA" to 2, "AA" to 3 ... etc., until you are back at "AA". Fill in the form provided.
8. Holding one end of your tape at "OO", measure to 1, then "OO" to 2, "OO" to 3 ... etc., until you are back at "AA". Fill in the form provided.
9. Cross Checks: Measure at least 4 cross checks. (Fig5)

i.e. 11 to 2 =
 7 to 17 =
 15 to 5 =
 19 to 6 =

On rectangular type pool, measure longest diagonals as well (See Figure 6)

1 to 3 = 5 to 1 =
 6 to 2 = 4 to 2 =

10. **Re-check all measurements as we are only as good as your measurements.**
11. If you have grab rails etc., that are closer than 300mm to the waters edge, draw and measure rails in relation to pool cover.
